The UK NSWP recognises and supports the rights of individual sex workers to self-determination. This includes the right to remain in sex work or leave sex work.

Using the directory

The projects in this directory are listed alphabetically by region. To help you find what you are looking for, the indexes (see pages 77–91) list projects alphabetically by project name and by region (with a map to help).

All the projects included are committed to promoting the health of sex workers. They come from different backgrounds and have a variety of approaches. Phone them to find out which is best for you.

All the projects provide condoms and general advice and support. This includes safe sex information and advice on safety. They can also refer you to other people if they cannot help you themselves.

Each project entry lists the services provided. Many of the services are available for anyone using the project. If there are sex worker-only sessions we have indicated this.

Most of the projects are open during office hours. Many have answerphones if you want to leave a message. If a project is open outside office hours, at night or over the weekend, we have indicated this. Services may change so it is best to call the project before visiting.

Most projects are open to male, female and transgender sex workers. Some are only open to women and a few only to men.

LEGAL ADVICE

Some projects provide specialist advice on welfare rights, housing and the law.

Sex Workers and the Law (published by Release, the National Legal and Drug Advice Bureau) is a guide to the laws governing the sex industry in England and Wales. It covers main offences (such as soliciting and importuning, brothel keeping, running escort agencies) and laws

relating to immigration, unlawful advertising, carrying offensive weapons, assault and tax evasion. It also contains information about police powers and practices; getting legal help; going to court; penalties; criminal records; safety; and a list of useful agencies. IN THE POLICE STATION YOU ALWAYS HAVE THE RIGHT:

- To be treated humanely and with respect
- To see the written codes governing your rights and how you are treated
- To speak to the custody officer (the officer must look after your welfare)
- To know why you have been arrested

YOU ALSO HAVE THE RIGHT (but in rare situations they can be delayed):

- To have someone notified of your arrest (not to make a phone call yourself)
- To consult with a solicitor privately

MEDICAL SERVICES

Some projects offer a range of services which may include:

- General (GP)
- STD checks
- Contraception and pregnancy testing
- Morning after pill
- Abortion counselling and referral
- HIV testing
- Hepatitis testing and vaccination

Clinics for sexually transmitted infections (Genito-Urinary Medicine clinics) and Family Planning clinics are also listed in your local phone book, or you can ask your local project for information. Project workers may be able to make appointments for you and go to these with you.

DRUG SERVICES

Drug advice, needle exchange and drug treatment are available at certain projects. Project workers should be able to refer you to your local drugs project.




